Primary School Survey Results
June 2026

The Department of Education and Youth recently carried out the Primary School Survey to gather the views of parents and guardians on:

- Co-educational or single-sex schooling
- School patronage and ethos
- Language of instruction (English or Irish)

The Board of Management is now sharing the survey results with our school community.

Survey Results

The results from parents and guardians of children currently attending Thomond Primary School show:

- 100% support for the school remaining co-educational.
- 79% support for the school remaining under its current catholic patronage.
- 91% support for education continuing through English.

A total of 43 families completed the survey, representing a 31% response rate.

The full survey report is available below, together with the Department's guide to understanding the results.

What Happens Next?

The Board of Management will review the survey results and the accompanying guidance from the Department of Education and Youth.

At the beginning of the new school year, the Board will engage further with parents, staff and the wider school community and will outline the opportunities available for people to share their views on the survey findings.

Following this engagement process, the Board will consider all feedback received and decide on any further steps. Any decisions made will be communicated to the school community.
